# Nixon Taping Interviews For Broadcast Overseas

Former President Richard Nixon, taping a series of television programs with David Frost, is taping four additional interviews that have been sold for exclusive viewing in four foreign countries.

Marvin Minoff, Frost's partner in the multimillion-dollar project, refused yesterday to confirm reports that each has been sold for \$250,000.

"It's up to the buyers to say," Minoff said in a telephone interview from Beverly Hills.

The foreign purchasers of the interviews are National Nine, an Australian network, French television, the Italian television network and the British Broadcasting Corp.

Each of the four interviews consists of questions and answers of special interest to viewers in the country where that particular show will be broadcast.

They will also be integrated into the 90-minute segments to be shown in the United States.
