Watergate Figure Ulasewicz Convicted on 2 Tax Counts

NEW YORK—A federal jury convicted Anthony Ulasewicz on two counts of tax fraud yesterday for failing to report on time the \$41,0000 he was paid for delivering more than \$200,000 to Watergate burglars who faced prosecution.

The verdict in U.S. District Court came one hour and 40 minutes after Judge Edward R. Neaher sent the case to the jury.

The former New York City policeman faces a sentence of six years in jail and a \$10,000 fine.
