



PURE NATURAL GUM RUBBER TUBING

This tubing is 3/16" in dismeter with a 1/8" hole. Many uses can be found for this lively rubber tubing. Following are just a few of its many uses.

It makes excellent slingshot thrust bands. Several lengths may be braided together to produce thrust bands of the exact tension desired and at the same time have much greater flexibility than a single tube of equal strength.

Using a piece about two feet long, surprising accuracy may be achieved by stretching and letting it "snap" at some object. When some skill has been aquired one can kill flies etc. consistently at about two and a half feet. Even pick them out of the air while in flight. Hice have also been dispatched in this way when a "flap" of inner tube rubber or leather was tied to the end of the tubing.

Carry a piece several feet long in your First Ald Kit, Snake Eite Kit or fishing tackle box for use as an emergency tourniquet. With a little imagination one can braid belts, watch bands etc. from this tubing.




