FORREST BOLDING, Aero-Medical Branch, Federal Aviation Agency (FAA), Oklahoma City, advised that GAAR was afforded a medical examination on 2/28/68, at which time he indicated his address as P.O. Box 2458, Managua, D.N. Nicaragua, and the examining doctor was CHARLES L. ROSER, 629 S. First St., Louisville, Kentucky. GAAR indicated on 2/28/68, that he is a self-employed crop duster and has been for the past five years. He is described as W/M, born 2/14/26, Louisville, Kentucky, 5'11", 150 lbs., brown eyes, brown hair.

In addition to the letter written to GAAR by Mrs. LAURA SULLINGER from Miami and the location of the arms and explosives on SULLINGER's farm in North Carolina, additional significance may be attached to the proposed interview with GAAR, since GAAR was previously arrested on 3/23/64, by Alcohol Tax Unit, George County, Mississippi, for operating an illegal still. At the time of his arrest, he had several weapons in his possession and a large supply of hate literature.

For the information of all offices, Mrs. LAURA
SULLINGER of Miami, Florida, is closely associated with Mrs.
MARGARET CAPOMACCHIA, mother of Mrs. KATHLEEN AINSWORTH (deceased),
formerly of Jackson, Mississippi, who was killed in a shootout

TARRANTS, III, while attempting to place 29 sticks of dynamite
rigged with a timing device at the home of a prominent Jewish
citizen, Meridian, on 6/30/68. TARRANTS was seriously wounded
and is still in custody at Meridian. Information in TARRANTS'
effects indicated he is a self-confessed member of the Minutemen
and has been operating underground since March, 1968. Current
investigation in Mississippi indicates TARRANTS and others may
have been in contact with ROBERT BOLIVER DEPUGH - FUGITIVE, 10
4176; however, DePUGH's whereabouts have not been determined.
