

Seize arms,  
spy gear  
on N. Side

A North Side man arrested for possessing a huge arsenal of weapons was released on \$10,000 bond Friday.

Victor Ostrow, 28, who lives with his parents at 6334 N. Sheridan, was charged with 45 counts of failure to register firearms and 4 counts of theft of firearms.

The weapons, as well as spy cameras and electronic eavesdropping equipment, were seized Thursday night in a police raid on his parents' second-floor apartment in the Sheridan Towers Condominiums.

The Secret service, notified that pictures of President Nixon were found with the cache, began an investigation.

Ostrow said he was a gun collector.
