Youth Killed in 'Games'

FORT COLLINS, Colo., Oct. 5 (UPI)—An investigation into what was thought to be an accidental shooting death has turned up evidence of a teenage paramilitary organization operating in northern Colorado.

Sheriff's juvenile officer Ed Rupert said Friday that Dennis Miller, 18, of Fort Collins, was killed last week while he and five other youths were

conducting war games outside the city.

"They were apparently playing hide-and-seek with loaded weapons, and firing shots," Rupert said. "The purpose of the group is to protect the national border against infiltration."

The investigator said the group supposedly has about 30 members in the northern Colorado area. "As far as we know, there were no adults leading the group," he said.
