GARY, Ind.—About 200 "extremely dangerous" anti-personnel mines, 300 pounds of black gunpowder and several primer caps were taken this week from a federal bunker in Gary, authorities said yesterday.

Indiana State Police said the mines were unusually sensitive and could explode if dropped.

Federal Bureau of Investigation Agents from Indianapolis joined state police and other federal investigators in a search for the ammunition.

Authorities said the mines measure 3½ by 1½ inches. The weapons do not explode so long as at least 50 pounds of pressure is applied to them. When the pressure is removed, the mines explode and have the capacity to kill anyone within 60 feet.
