

Ex-Nazi Unit Now Selling Guns by Mail

The former American Nazi Party, which has been urging the war for more than a decade, now is selling guns by mail in anticipation of a Negro uprising.

By telephone, direct mail and advertisements in party publications, the group is offering for sale what it calls "negro control equipment" ranging from riot guns to chemical mace.

The operation, which started recently, is run by William Pierce, assistant executive director of the party, located in his family home in Virginia, adjacent to the Marine Corps base. The group, now known as the National Socialist Movement Party, was organized in 1944. Its membership has grown to about 100,000.

At the time of the party's formation, it was known as the National Socialist Party. It was founded by George Lincoln Rockwell, a former Marine and a member of the party's executive committee. Rockwell was killed in 1966. Pierce, who succeeded him, is the party's current leader.
