# 'I was in CIA'

## Sex-case medic:

Dr. James G. Middleton, who has been charged with drug-  
ging and sexually assaulting two women patients, testified  
in Federal Court Monday that he worked for the Central  
Intelligence Agency from 1951 to 1953.

Dr. Middleton is on trial before U.S. District Court Judge  
James B. Parsons on charges of illegal possession of ex-  
plosives. The charges, stemming from the alleged sexual  
assaults, are pending in the Criminal Courts.

DR. MIDDLETON testified to his work for the CIA under  
cross-examination by federal prosecutors who questioned  
him about his previous training in the use of explosives. Dr.  
Middleton said he was not at liberty to answer questions  
about the nature of the CIA work.

Treasury agents seized gunpowder in a raid on Dr. Mid-  
dleton's office at 969 Elmhurst Rd., Des Plaines, in Febru-  
ary. Dr. Middleton told Judge Parsons he was using ex-  
plosive materials in research to develop flares for signalling  
devices he hoped to market.
