I'm willing for the interview but with two conditions: I will not go into conjecture but will stick to fact in the questions and it would be on a Saturday or a Sunday. As of now almost any one but the sooner the better.

By fact I mean what is fact according to the official evidence, not what the government or private people regard as fact.

And often is not.

I suggest that you make a list of what you want to go into and we can go over that at lunch and you can understand why, if there are matters on it that I regard as conjecture, we can discuss them and you can understand why I won't go into them in the interview. If there are any on your list.

If you want you can tape that discussion and have a record of what I steer away from.
