

Medical malpractice seminar set Monday, June 30, at FCC

Dr. Cyril H. Wecht, coroner of Allegheny County, Pennsylvania, will be the featured speaker at a Medical Malpractice Seminar scheduled Monday, June 30, from 7 to 10 p.m. at Frederick Community College.

The seminar is open to the public, but it is primarily designed for physicians, nurses, hospital administrators and lawyers. Dr. Wecht will focus on the current malpractice situation, its causes, implications, resolutions, and he will speculate on what the future holds. Special attention will be directed toward situations relating to Maryland and time will be set aside for questions and answers.

Dr. Wecht holds degrees in both medicine and law. He is a member of the American Medical Association, the American Bar Association, the College of American Pathologists and is a Fellow of the American Association for Forensic Science and the American Society of Clinical Pathologists. In addition, he has lectured extensively and has appeared on several national television network programs.

Following Dr. Wecht's presentation, a panel consisting of Dr. Richard Crouse, Robert Smith, Mrs. Agnes Kemerer, Wallace Dow, and Dr. R. R. Roberts will react to and raise questions relating to
