Dear Dr. Sacht,

I have heard nothing further from the magazine.

The Kennedy assassination Inquiry Committee was formerly the New York branch of the national Citizens' Committee of Inquiry, whose headquarters were in Los Angeles. It is run by someone named Brent Gough, about whom I know little. I met him once.

I have no reason to doubt the seriousness of his purpose, I saw him the end of October. He then told me of his plan to arrange for an off-Broadway theater to present the "critical". The second one is scheduled for tonight. It includes Vincent Salandria, Thompson and Richard Sprague, who has done very well in his work on the pictures.

Gough asks me to be there 2/19, which may not be possible, and 2/26. It is possible he asks me on the 13th and I forget the date, knowing I'll be away then. If you would like to know more about Gough, besides Vincent and Ned, who you may not know, Sylvia Wagner might be able to tell you. I think I'll see you on his first program.

But I hope we meet soon.

I'll leave 2/1 and return about 2/18-19.

Thank you for having sent me a copy of the G.S.A. - Kennedy Family Agreement. I am glad to have it in my files.


Your comments regarding the possible tampering of your mail are interesting. I shall perhaps make inquiry locally concerning the envelope that you returned to me from my previous correspondence.
