Memorandum Relative to the Efficiency Rating Sent
Mr. Harold Weisberg for the Period from May 15,
1936, to March 31, 1937.

As stated in the memorandum of Mr. William F. Callander, Comptroller, Agricultural Adjustment Administration, under date of April 10, 1937, Mr. Weisberg was detailed to Mr. Lollar of the Cotton Section from May 13, 1936, to August 2, 1936. He was returned to the Office of the Comptroller August 3, 1936, and was assigned to the File Section under the supervision of Mr. Rogers, to and including August 26, 1936. On August 27, 1936, he was detailed to the Subcommittee of the Committee on Education and Labor, United States Senate, and he still is on detail to this committee.

The efficiency rating given Mr. Weisberg covered only his services in the Agricultural Adjustment Administration, and not his services with the Subcommittee of the Committee on Education and Labor, United States Senate.
