It was thought by the members that the management are going to be more friendly toward them in the future, and there will be a new time study made in the dept. where the trouble all started at.

It was known today that one linetype machine and the large press was broke down at the Exchange printing co plant. this delayed all the printing work that is being done for the Rubber Workers Convention. However they did get out the job for the special meeting called by the Diamond match local. These were made up in Hand bill form and will be passed out at the gate we are told.

Plans were farthered at the Chemical meeting tonight for the proposed picketing of the plant next Tues. we are told, and all employees will be warned to carry a union card. The match had a notice up at their headquarters today that the Federal Match in Penna. and the Palmer Match in Kenmore were now 100% organized.
