Dear Mr. Weisberg:

Reference is made to your letter addressed to The Adjutant General, Washington, D. C., requesting information regarding your military record, together with the mailing addresses of certain men with whom you served.

The records show that at the time of induction, Harold Weisberg, Army serial number 32 484 933, was found physically qualified for limited service only, by reason of insufficient vision and sacro-iliac strain. Subsequently, the designation "limited service" was lined out on his service record. However, the date or reason therefor is not shown. No additional information regarding the classification prior to 4 May 1944 at Walter Reed General Hospital has been found.
