

'Who Killed JFK?'
Milton Topic Sept. 30

MILTON — Harold Weisberg, author of several books challenging the Warren Commission Report of the Assassination of John F. Kennedy, will be guest speaker at Milton College on Friday, Sept. 30.

His topic, "Who Killed JFK?" will be presented at 1 p.m. in the Daland Fine Arts Center auditorium.

A native of Philadelphia, Weisberg sprang into national prominence with his book "Whitewash," about the Warren Report, which was printed privately in 1966. Weisberg's series of books on the assassination are considered by some sources the most reliable and thoroughly documented works on every aspect of the assassination and the attendant botched investigation.

A former Senate investigator, Weisberg's persistent lawsuits have made it possible for him to obtain import-

ant documents, many withheld even from the 28 supplementary volumes of the Warren Report. Weisberg's skepticism of the finding and his expertise in the material will enlighten the audience.
