Warren report critic to speak on findings

The recent disclosure of the
x-rays and photographs of Pres-
ident Kennedy's autopsy has again
raised many questions about the
assassination.

One of the foremost critics
of the method in which the Warren
Commission handled the investi-
gation, Harold Welsberg, will
speak at 7:30 p.m. Thursday in
the Student Union Ballroom.

In a recent interview, Welsberg
stated that he felt that facts as
represented by the public news
services did not "stack up." Im-
mediately after the assassination,
Welsberg started his own investi-

gation and began to write a book
telling of his findings.

In his book, "Whitewash,"
Welsberg has come upon some
interesting theories about the
assassination of John Kennedy.
Welsberg feels that Cuban refo-
gees were involved in the assas-
sination plot and that Oswald was
not the sole person involved in
the actual shooting.

He believes that Oswald was
denied his Constitutional rights
and that had he been properly
tried, he would have proved in-
nocent.
Welsberg feels that security

measures for the President were
as tight and efficient as they
could possibly have been, and has
cited Rufus Youngblood, Pres-
idential guard, for his bravery.

Welsberg has criticized the
Warren Commission for many of
its conclusions and its methods
of investigation. He feels that
the recently disclosed x-rays and
photos of the autopsy should be
disclosed to qualified persons
and not guarded as tenaciously
as they have been.

Welsberg will answer ques-
tions tonight as well as introduce
his book, which is in its fourth
printing.
