Herewith all I can dig up on publicity for Harold. I am sure there is more that could be more informative, but he keeps such files and I am at a loss in locating them, not having any idea where to begin. I hope that what I am sending will be of some value to you.

In addition to his extensive knowledge of the assassinations, by now he is also an authority on the Freedom of Information Act, having made more use of it in court than any other individual. He has two cases in court now, one on the JFK case and the other, the currently more active one if the number of status calls are counted, is for additional information on the MLK case. The information sought in this suit is needed for his second book on that case; about two-thirds completed, it awaits the documentation the Department of Justice is desperately typing to prevent his acquiring.

You asked about his fee. All I can tell you is that he has been receiving \$750 plus expenses. However, I think it would be best if you discussed this with himm personally. As I told you on the phone, he will be home Sudday night. I can't be sure of the time.

It was a pleasure to talk with you and with Flo. I am sure you enjoyed having her with you. Harold is also fond of her and he'll regret that he wasn't here to speak with her himself. My regret is that I know her only by phone.

I hope that you, the college and Harold will be able to work out an arrangement. If you do, I may like to visitmSalisbury again with him. It has been a long time since we've been in that area.
