**Will Talk**

Harold Weisberg, stand-out critic of the Warren Commission, will speak at San Diego State College at 8 p.m. Tuesday in Room 100 of the Social Sciences building.

Weisberg's investigation of the assassination of President John F. Kennedy began even before the Warren Report was released, and his careful research and dynamic presentation have brought the story of the conspiracy national recognition.

He is the author of Oswald in New Orleans and the Whitewash series. In the introduction to the book Oswald in New Orleans, New Orleans District Attorney Jim Garrison stated, "The question now is whether we have the courage to come face to face with ourselves and admit that something is wrong, whether we have the will to insist on an end to deception and concealment with regard to the execution of John Kennedy, or whether we will let the official fairy tale be told and re-told until the truth itself fades into a vagrant rumor and finally dies forever."

Weisberg will speak as a part of the program of the Experimental College at San Diego State, a student conceived and organized extracurricular program which sponsors classes in a number of non-academic subjects. Weisberg is being brought to San Diego by the Assassination Inquiry Committee.
