Author Of JFK Slaying Expose U. Of M. Guest

Whitewash—current bestseller condemning the Warren Commission's report on the assassination of President Kennedy—will be discussed by its author, Harold Weisberg of Hyattsown, Tuesday, July 12, at a coffee hour at the College Park campus of the University of Maryland.

The coffee hour, which is free and open to the public, will be held in the Student Union Lounge from 3 to 5 p.m.

In his book, Weisberg maintains that the Warren investigation was superficial and incomplete. The commission failed to consider that someone other than Lee Harvey Oswald could have been the Presidents' assassin, he contends.

Weisberg further writes, "Never in history have such crimes been solved by such a consistent disregard for truth, honesty, and credibility."
