True, but bound to be
regarded as nit-picking.

This is true of most
shells that are found
at the scene of a
shooting.

⑧ I don't think there is
any evidence that "residues
were wiped off the bullet".
All we know is what
Frayser says: That when
he received the bullet,
the bullet was "clean"
(he does not even say
"cleaned"). There is
no evidence that the
bullet ever had "residue"
of any type, except in
the case where Frayser mentions
"substance" or "material" or some
indeterminate phrase of that type
