Mr. Robert $\pi-$ West, Surveyor, who made the plat maps of the assassination area requested the Bureau to furnish him copies made from the original tracing which he had furnished to the Bureau on $5 / 31 / 64$. Inasmuch as the Bureau had no authority to comply with this request, the matter was referred to the Criminal Division of the Justice Department for handling.

Mr. Cella, Department attorney, phone 187-2660, called me today and asked if I could determine what it would cost to have six prints made from the tracing which is in the possession of the Exhibits Section. He stated that Attorney Howard Willing who was Administrative Assistant to Mr 。 Rankin requested this information Mr. Cella was advised that this information would be obtained and furnished to him.
