Dear Mr. Weisberg:

I have been transferred to Philadelphia and in the process, I neglected to answer your letter of August 6, 1967.

After receiving your letter I reviewed our broadcast of November 22, 1966, consisting of an interview with Malcolm Kilduff, former Assistant Press Secretary to President Kennedy. This program involved an eye-witness and was timely as broadcast material for the Third Anniversary of the tragic occurrence surrounding the death of President Kennedy.

We recognize that there are many views and theories concerning the facts surrounding this tragedy, most of which, from time to time, have been adequately reported through our various programs. Should additional facts develop in the future, we will of course report them as they are revealed. We do not believe, however, that any further discussion in general, or a specific comment on Mr. Kilduff's broadcast of November 22, 1966, is required by the public interest.

We will keep your interest in the general subject in mind, however, for further consideration at some future date, should the matter again become important to the general public.
