

Wheeler, Nye Meet Kamp

WASHINGTON, Nov. 17. Senator Burton K. Wheeler (D., Mont.), and Senator Gerald P. Nye, (R., N. D.), have been meeting with the bush league friend of fascism, Joseph P. Kamp, and one Michael Ahearn to help plot Wheeler's investigation of John Roy Carlson.

Carlson's book on the undercover activities of native Nazis and fascists gives considerable space to Kamp, who is a ghost-writer for anti-Semitic pamphlets, among them "Native Nazi Purge Plot."

Ahearn and Kamp met with Wheeler and Nye in the latter's office Monday. Wheeler's investigation is expected to get under way within a few weeks. The Montana isolationist is said to be loading his guns with information given him by such persons as Frank Clark and Hudson de Priest, both of whom are under indictment for sedition.

The tentative schedule of witnesses includes Walter Winchell, Rex Stout, Walter Birkhead and representatives of the Anti-Nazi League who have attacked Wheeler's stand on foreign affairs.

The other members of the Wheeler investigating group are Senator John Danaher (R., Conn.), and Sen. Abe Murdock, (D., Utah).
