Statements of Witnesses - Dr. Martin G. WHITE

Almost half of the brief statement is occupied with introduction. Dr. White put an intravenous cut down the President's right foot and didn't observe any wounds. He left before the President was pronounced dead. Among the doctors he identifies as being there was a Dr. William Zedelitz.

Zedelitz was not called. I can see no reason why White was, either.
