Dear Mr. Lesar:

I am responding to your Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request of August 7, 1990, for a copy of the personnel record on Mr. Roscoe A. White and the manifest for the USS BEXAR for a voyage which departed from San Diego, California on August 22, 1957 and disembarked at Yokosuka, Japan on September 12, 1957.

Enclosure (1) contains all releasable information contained in the Official Military Personnel Files (OMPF) of Mr. White. Personal information pertaining to the next of kin and other living individuals in the record of Mr. White is exempt under 5 U.S.C. 552(b)(6) of the FOIA. Specifically, it exempts from disclosure information in personnel and medical files, as well as information in similar files that, if disclosed to a member of the public would result in a clearly unwarranted invasion of personal privacy.

We have no record of a previous release of the enclosed record under the FOIA. Mr. White's record indicates that release of information was made to his next of kin.


Because your request has been partially denied, you may appeal this decision to the Judge Advocate General (Code 34), Navy Department, 200 Stovall Street, Alexandria, VA 22332-2400. You must submit the appeal to that office within 60 calendar days from the date of this letter in order to be considered, and attach the duplicate copy of this letter. We recommend that the letter of appeal and the envelope both bear the notation, "Freedom of Information Act Appeal."

The cost associated with processing your request under the FOIA amounts to \$34.45. At your earliest convenience, please forward a check in that amount, made payable to the Treasurer of the United States, to the following address:
