I'm returning the article that you submitted along with your manuscript.

I read your manuscript hastily, but enough to realize what a complete and thorough job it is. I don't want to venture any opinion as to the conclusions you reached, although certainly it seems to me there are large areas of gray and large blanks in the Warren Report itself.

I am going to turn it down for publication, however, not for the reasons that you might suspect, but simply out of my own feeling that the public has had enough of the criticism of the Warren Report and awaits a book which will actually turn up new evidence or concretely fill in the gaps that were left by the Warren Report. In short, I don't think it's enough anymore simply to raise the questions as you have done in your manuscript.
