Thank you for your note of September 27, telling me about Sidney Kauffman's having a copy of your manuscript.

I've talked to Sol Stein since his return from Europe: I'm afraid I must tell you that his reaction to THE REPORT ON THE WARREN REPORT was not particularly enthusiastic. He wanted to know more specifically, and in summary, what your conclusions are (beyond the mere conclusion that The Warren Commission had not done the full or proper job) and said to me in a memo: "Before spending time on a huge manuscript, I'd want to know as much as we'd have to tell the public, say, in catalogue copy." To give you an idea of the length he refers to, I'm enclosing a copy of Stein and Day's latest catalogue.
