To make a full record at one point I'll repeat what you may remember.

First, the sews of issediate interest: I have sold the use of the Ford part of the sew book to the National Star for a skingy \$200, negtly out of concern for your bank and partly because of the stipulation I attached in accepting their offer from Roger today: they three in either mux ad or include in the story how readers can get the book and the price. Roger has agreed and he thinks they will. If they don't, with your paraission I'll decline.

From the tops they had a man in Hamphis, we spoke, I heard nothing so after talking to you I should them in HIC and got a call-back from Nevard, an editor. He was excited but because it and taken him so long to return the call, days ofter he had been supposed to, I had should harper's and spoken to beaks haphas. You know that story of nothings.

I proposed to Roger, who prest some time here, a series of three stories he saw, MOT including this Ford one because! was confident his sheet would not go for it. But when Roger read he regarded that as what it is, a major story. He persisted in it and scared the hell out of everyone at the Star. This is why they backed off and why we did not all serialization of at least three stories. (The Enguirer man also saw three minimum.)

last I'd heard they were still running and he was still pushing. Today he phoned to tell is they's o.k'ed.

he had taken this up with the "hite house, askings Did Ford given the money to some charity and if so which; Did he use classified documents? He expected to be brushed off, in part because with a perfectly normal thing, an existing family picture, he was six weeks after publication of the story before he got it, at least two months in all.

But htys did call back to tell him: Ho charity; and no classified doocuments at all, only what the Warren Consission published - with one teensy-weensy except, a sort of small error lack Stiles had made.

Roger made notes anche is going to give them to be for archival filing, no restrictions.

This also means that the White Bonse, if it didn't earlier, knows about our book. They have asked for no paper on the deal but I did offer it. This also makes a record of that because it is copyrighted. It is to protect them.

Now it is also interesting that one of the things they are giving Roger the runaround on is a report they got that Ford is building in Colorado. At Aspen, not Vale, where it is known that Ford has a property. To could get no answer from the WH and he known at GiM - you guess it - Vawter, who denied promptly. Roger has the same opinion of Vawter E do.

I was able to make some suggestions on how he could check the story further so I did and he will.

Here is what hap ened at the Star once Hoger proposed the Ford story: they suddenly had not received the book andhe couldn't get anyone to read the stuff when he went there and wrote. So he was getting turned down all the time by those who professed no knowledge of the story or the record on which it is based! He persisted until he finally got someone to read it and thus the go-whead. But the sum is an inpult and is not indicative of sujor attention. Or they are gypting us wors.

Thus also one of my reasons for stipulating how the book can be bought as part of the deal. They do sell about a million copies, to people who seek sensation.
