The first printing of the book, "Whitewash," which questions the Warren Commission's report on the assassination of President Kennedy, has been sold out, according to its author.

Harold Weisburg of Hyattstown reported that a second printing of 5000 books has been ordered. Weisburg, former newspaper and magazine writer, Senate investigator and political analyst, is publishing the book at his own expense.

The Montgomery Countian indicated that he has been kept busy since the book first hit the stands two months ago. He said agreement has just been reached with the newspaper Arriba, in Madrid, Spain, for serialization of his book.

Inquiries about the possibility of publishing it have come from as far away as New Zealand, Weisberg said, and the book is under consideration by a Japanese publisher. The author said he has appeared as a guest on television shows scheduled for screening in New York and Philadelphia.
