There is a reflection of this in attached 62-109090-238, a report for the Reserve papers by Los Whitten, written the day after the Report was published.

Barely legible at the bottom is a steep indicating that a deleted copy was sent to Whitten with a letter of 9/21/76.

Obviously no purpose would have been served by deleting parts of the story Whitten bisself had written and was published.

What remains in the Hoover community "A real debunking of the PEI which we will never live down."

If there is an applicable exception of the act I do not think of it. And why should the FoI have sithhold from Whitten what it did not withhold from so and placed in its ressing room, available to all others?
