B. degree in 1953. He attended Yale Law School, en Laven, Connecticut, receiving his LL.B degree in 1956. Z During the investigation of Loward Penney Willens, ali ndividuals contacted reported favorably as to Willen's character, loyalty, and associates. The Vienna Festival, in 1959, was supported by the Moria Federation of perocratic Youth, cited as a communist organization in the Rouse Committee on Un-American Activities Guide to Subversive Organizations and Fublications, January 2, 1957. Prior to going abroad, Willens advised the State Department and the Dureau of his intentions to attend the Restival and stated his purpose was to minimize propagard and defend the policies of the United States. Joseph Robert Millens was interviewed by Dureau frents on May 19, 1961, and advised that he had visited wish in 1956 with five other individuals from Chicago, who dere interested in home building and construction. Le also advised that he has visited humany, Dulgaria and Burania on with-seeing tours, as well as to see types of construction withized in home building. Le stated that he is opposed to communism and the types of overment existing behind the iron curtain. Le denied any affiliation with the Chicago Council of American-Soviet Friendship, and stated most emphatically that he has never been a never or in car way associated with that he has never been a herier or in any way associated with the Chicago Council of American-Joviet Friendship or any similar lorganization.

Joseph Robert Willens admitted that Tony Accardo's residence is immediately south of his Love in River Porest, Illinois, and that they had been neighbors since 1950. Lestated that he does not associate with Accardo, or any of his friends. He also advised that he and his family are law-abiding citizens and believe themselves to be good Americans, and he hopes that the proximity of his residence with that of Accardo would not cause any or helicity that he will be and a second to helicity and he had a second to not cause anyone to believe that he approves of Accardo or any of his associates.
