I believe by this time you have received my manorandum reflecting a conference held a few days ago with lim. Sturmen and likes Farrar requiring the Commission's files. As I indicated in that manorandum, the Archives specialist intends establishing an extensive file on persons mentioned in the investigative reports. In each person's file will be contained copies of the pages of the reports which concern them.

It is apparent that this effort duplicates the name index currently in preparation under the supervision of Mr. Blawson. I do not think that both projects should be done shadtaneously with the resultant waste of our limited numpover. It is my recommondation that the work on the name index be stopped and the results of this work be made available to Miss Farrar. I think that any additional accretarial time that is available should be utilized by hiss Farrar on the overall Commission files.
