

Memorandum to Mr. (Flaherty)
RE: Assassination of President John F. Kennedy

As a possible resolution to Mr. Fink's questions, GID has determined from the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) Section of the Files and Communications Division that the Archives still has 222 FBI documents which have been withheld from research or public release. Of these 222 documents, 109 are Unclassified, 95 are Confidential, 17 are Secret, and 1 is Top Secret.

FOIA is currently involved in a review of the withheld documents to determine which may now be released. This review is done at five-year intervals. FOIA has thus far completed only a preliminary review of the documents. Personnel of FOIA involved in the review recall none of the documents being teletypes.
