

Women Form Pacifist Group

CHICAGO, June 12.—A new organization, patterned after the pro-fascist We, the Mothers, Mobilize for America, has opened up offices in Chicago's Loop, and is flooding the city with "Peace Now" and anti-invasion propaganda.

Known as the Women's League for Political Education, the group is headed by Mrs. Grace G. Keefe, formerly secretary of We, the Mothers, as national secretary. Also active in the enterprise is Mrs. Florence Hoban-Kriesel, another former member of the Mothers group.

Literature distributed by the League carries extensive quotations from recent speeches criticizing the war effort by Sen. C. Waylan ("Curly") Brooks, darling of the *Chicago Tribune*, Rep. Clare Hoffman (R., Mich.) and Rep. Jessie Sumner (R., Ill.) who prior to the Allied landings in France this week introduced a resolution in Congress demanding postponement of the European invasion.
