Dear r. Wright,

Your order for our books, originally dated 8/1, was held up and redated 10/9. We have just received it. The books were sent by insured book rate this evening. We have sent them as directed. The bill (copy of it and order enclosed) is at book-store and institutional discount.

I have been continuing my work, at a somewhat diminished pace. The addition to COUP D'ETAT, dealing entirely with the King/Ray case, is being retyped. It will run about 200,000 words.

Recently I have obtained more material of the kind that is shocking in context, in some ^{ways} more more than anything I have yet discovered, and is an indescribable commentary on the functioning of government in a "free" and "open" society. As time goes on I become more convinced that my work will make two quite significant archives: one on the assassinations and one on government.

I do regret that you have not had occasion to visit this part of the country so that you might see what I do have.
