He was the driver of the car in which the Mayor and his wife and a Congressman were riding. He also says that his car also had turned into Elm Street and gome about 30 feet from the intersection when he heard the first shot.

It is surprising how many different cars under how many different drivers and how many different engines in them were in almost precisely the same spot!

The concluding sentence of Patrolman Wright's statement says, "we were instructed to kepp the news media away from the car."
