I hesitate to write you when I have nothing concrete to say, I hate to take your time which is so limited. If you don't answer I will understand .--- I had a meeting with an old friend John Rich, he produced and directed a TV series, "All In The Family." If you are not familiar with the show it deals with present day bigotry and politics in a franker way than most shows. With this background I thought he might be interested as he is a ballsy guy but he declined involvement for getting your book published. He was not to up on the Kennedy murder. Bert Schneider informed me he is retiring and would not be interested. Maybe he got a message. His 44 year old brother in the midst of producing a movie, "Six Days of The Condor, a story of the CIA, was found dead of a heart attack in his New York apt. a couple of months age. This could be discourageing. At present I am arranging two more meetings.--- I was in Papa Bach book store last week and was pleased to see that they had all of your books for sale .-- May 16, 17, 18 at UCLA there is going to be a symposium on the intelligence community and assassinations. Among those listed are Mae Brussell, Don Freed, Mark Lane Geo. O'Toole, Rusty Rhodes, Peter Dale Scott, Wm. Turner and others. I imagine books will be sold at this gathering and I was wondering if yours will be there, or would you be out here for this meeting? It is being put on by an outfit,
