ALLEGED EFFORTS TO
INFLUENCE TESTIMONY OF
EDWARD GRADY PARTIN
OOJ, CR

GEORGE WYATT, 5327 Cameron Boulevard, New Orleans,
283-4448, telephonically contacted the writer at 2:50 p.m.,
1/13/69 and advised as follows:

At approximately 1:30 p.m., WYATT, while at his
residence, received a telephone call from a male individual
who refused to identify himself and who stated that something
is going to happen to WYATT. This individual did not furnish
any further details but did state that he wanted to meet with
WYATT on 1/14/69, preferably in a bar across from the Roosevelt
Hotel. WYATT stated that this individual sounded scared himself.

WYATT stated that the individual sounded a little
bit like PERRY RAYMOND RUSSO, with whom he is acquainted.
WYATT has no reason to believe that RUSSO would have any infor-
mation in which WYATT would be involved.

The individual is to call WYATT on 1/14/69 and set
up an exact time and place for the meeting. WYATT stated that
he would meet with this individual if he calls back and confirms
the appointment.

WYATT stated that while he realized the FBI could take
no action in connection with the above matter, he merely wanted
to let the Bureau know about the call and the fact that he would
meet with this person if the appointment was confirmed.

WYATT was informed that his meeting with the indi-
vidual would be entirely his own decision and WYATT stated he
was well aware of it.
