**Former Ku Klux Klan Head  
Held in Theft of Explosives**

BIRMINGHAM, Ala., Aug. 20 (AP)—The Federal Bureau of Investigation said today it had arrested Kenneth Adams, a former Ku Klux Klan leader, in connection with the theft of a large cache of explosives from Fort McClellan.

Everett Ingram, an F.B.I. agent in the Birmingham office, said Mr. Adams, a 45-year-old oil dealer in Anniston, appeared before United States Commissioner Ruby Price Robinson in Anniston on a charge of having received stolen Government property.

Bond was set at \$5,000, and Mr. Adams was placed in the Calhoun County jail.

Mr. Ingram said the arrest followed an indictment by a Federal grand jury in Birmingham yesterday.
