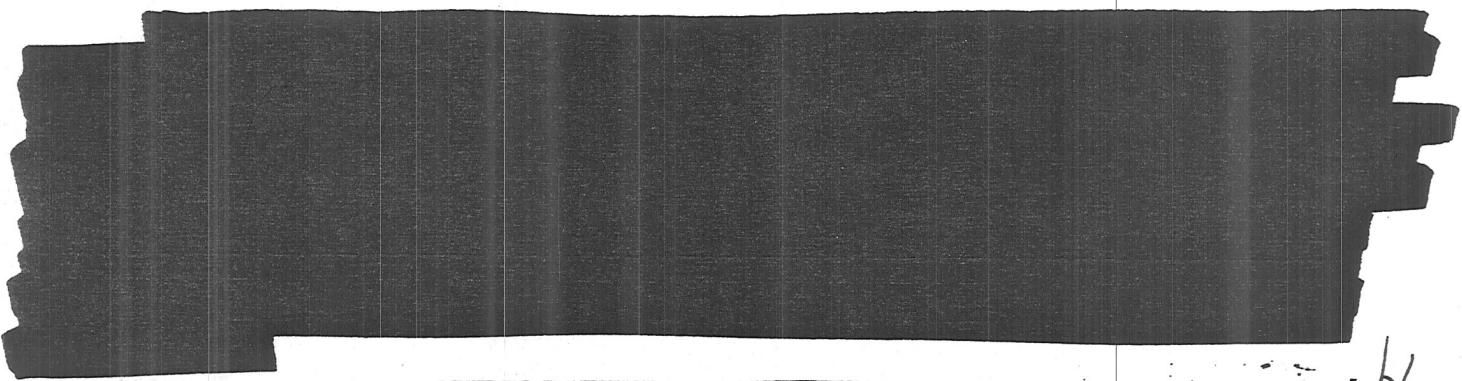

On 12-13-63 he was CENSURED and PLACED ON PROBATION inasmuch as it had been determined that his recent handling of a security-type case was grossly inadequate. He was responsible for conducting an inadequate investigation including earlier interview of the wife of Lee Harvey Oswald, delayed reporting, failure to put Oswald on Security Index, and for holding investigation in abeyance after being in receipt of information that Oswald had been in contact with the Soviet Embassy in Mexico City. In view of the information developed concerning Lee Harvey Oswald, it should have been apparent to SA Hosty that Oswald required a status which would have insured further investigative attention.



RECOMMENDATION:

That he be removed from probation at this time.
