Specifically, he was responsible for conducting an inadequate investigation including failure to interview Lee Harvey Oswald's wife, delayed reporting, failure to put Oswald on Security Index, and for holding investigation in abeyance after being in receipt of information that Oswald had been in contact with the Soviet Embassy, Mexico City. In view of the information developed concerning Oswald, it should have been apparent to him that he required a status which yould have insured further investigative attention.
