On 10/19/73, at the request of the above Agent, I had a conference with him in the Kansas City Office of the Director.

Agent Hosty outlined to me the problems he has encountered in the period he was assigned to the Lee Harvey Oswald case in Dallas, Texas, in 1963. This was a rather involved matter and I asked him to write to me outlining the matters fully. This has now been received and the purpose of this memo is to record the fact we did have the interview.

It appeared to me Agent Hosty seeks only vindication and has no purpose other than this in seeking a conference. He said he is happy in his assignment in Kansas City and by no means intends for his request to be interpreted as anything more than to have the record set straight.

In conformance with his request I will review the matter carefully, and after having done so he should be informed of my decision in the matter. Pursuant to this a tickler should be set up for 11/15/73, to provide some sort of an acknowledgment to him.
