INVESTIGATION BY THE PITTSEURGH DIVISION IN THIS MATTER WAS LIMITED TO INVESTIGATION TWO OR THREE LEADS TO THE EFFECT THAT OSWALD MAY HAVE BEEN IN THE PENNSYLVANIA OR WEST VIRGINIA AREA AT A GIVEN PERIOD OF TIME. SUBSEQUENT INVESTIGATION IN THIS MATTER DETERMINED THAT IN EACH INSTANCE THE INFORMATION WAS INCORRECT AND THERE WAS NO EVIDENCE TO SUBSTANTIATE THE FACT THAT CSWALD HAD EVER BEEN IN THIS AREA. THERE WERE SEVERAL LEADS REGARDING INDIVIDUALS WHO MIGHT POSSIBLY HAVE HAD SOME PRICE KNOWLEDGE OF THE ASSASSINATION BUT INVESTIGATION INTO THIS MATTER DETERMINED THAT ONCE AGAIN, THERE WAS NO SUESTANTIVE EVIDENCE. THE REMAINDER OF THE PITTSEURGH FILE CONTAINS MAINLY NEWSPAPER CLIPPINGS RELATIVE TO THE ASSASSINATION AND TO THE WARREN COMMISSION PEPCRI.

THE REMAINDER
