THING WHICH WAS REPORTED TO THE FBI AND THE PERSON INVOLVED WAS INTERVIEWED. A LISTING OF CONFIDENTIAL INFORMANTS WHO WERE CONTACTED IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE ASSASSINATION. MOST OF THE MATERIAL WAS INFORMATION RECEIVED FROM DALLAS, THE OFFICE OF ORIGIN, OR FROM OTHER OFFICES REQUESTING BIRMINGHAM INTERVIEW SOMEONE LIVING IN THE BIRMINGHAM DIVISION WHO ALLEGEDLY KNEW SOMETHING ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION. THERE ALSO ARE NEWSPAPER CLIPPINGS IN THE FILE SUCH AS EDITORIALS REGARDING THE MATTER. NO TAPES, ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE LOGS, OR BULKY EXHIBITS ARE CONTAINED IN THIS FILE. THERE ARE NO SUB FILES. THERE IS ONE PHOTOGRAPH OF J. A. MILTEER, A CITIZEN OF GEORGIA WHO MADE CERTAIN REMARKS ABOUT THE ASSASSINATION AND WAS INTERVIEWED.

THIS FILE CONTAINS MAINLY INFORMATION FROM OTHER OFFICES AND REQUESTS FOR PERSON TO BE INTERVIEWED, WHICH WERE UNPRODUCTIVE. THIS FILE CONTAINS AN AIRTEL FROM THE BUREAU TO INDIANAPOLIS, JANUARY 27, 1964, SETTING FORTH INFORMATION THAT OSWALD HAD APPARENTLY BEEN IDENTIFIED AS A PASSENGER ON A BUS TRAVELING FROM NUEVO LAREDO, MEXICO TO MEXICO CITY, SEPTEMBER 26, 1963. OSWALD TOLD [REDACTED]
