HOUSE SELECT COMMITTEE ON ASSASSINATIONS.

RE BUTEL DATED JANUARY 6, 1977, CAPTIONED AS ABOVE.

A REVIEW OF JACKSON INDICES DISCLOSED THREE FILES PERTAINING TO MATTERS SET OUT IN RE BUTEL. THESE FILES ARE DESCRIBED AS FOLLOWS:

"ASSASSINATIONS OF PRESIDENT JOHN FITZGERALD KENNEDY, NOVEMBER 22, 1963, DALLAS, TEXAS, MISCELLANEOUS - INFORMATION CONCERNING BUFILE 62-109860 AND JACKSON FILE 175-5."

THIS FILE OPENED SEPTEMBER 3, 1964 AND RUC'D SEPTEMBER 25, 1975. IT CONSISTS OF ONE VOLUME WITH 86 PAGES. IT CONTAINS INVESTIGATIONS RELATING TO INFORMATION ABOUT NINE INDIVIDUALS,

SOME OF WHOM CLAIMED TO HAVE KNOWLEDGE OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY'S

ASSASSINATION. THESE INDIVIDUALS WERE INTERVIEWED AND RESULTS IN EACH INSTANCE FURNISHED TO BUREAU IN LHM FORM. THERE ARE NO TAPED, ELECTRONIC SURVEILLANCE LOGS AND/OR TRANSCRIPTS IN THIS FILE. A PHOTOGRAPH OF ONE COMPLAINANT AND SEVERAL OF AN ATTACHE CASE WITH CONTENTS WERE RECOVERED IN THE I-A SECTION WITH THE NOTATION THAT SUCH PHOTOGRAPHS WERE SENT TO BUREAU, JUNE 22, 1967. THERE IS NO BULKY EXHIBIT SECTION.

THE SECOND FILE IS CAPTIONED "JACK L. RUBY, AKA LEE HARVEY OSWALD, AKA - VICTIM; CR BUFILE 44-24016 AND JACKSON FILE 44-895". THIS CASE WAS OPENED JANUARY 3, 1965, AND RUC'D ON FEBRUARY 12, 1965. IT CONSISTS OF 16 SERIALS. INVESTIGATION CONCERNS AN ANONYMOUS LETTER TO THE CHIEF OF POLICE, DALLAS, TEXAS, FROM A "PRISONER" ALLEGEDLY CONFINED AT JACKSON, MISS., WHO REPORTED HE HAD INFORMATION TO PROVE A CONSPIRACY BETWEEN RUBY AND OSWALD. MOST SERIALS ARE INTER-OFFICE TYPE CONTAINING INVESTIGATIVE RESULTS OF ATTEMPTS TO IDENTIFY THE WRITER. THE I-A SECTION CONTAINS HANDWRITING SAMPLES OF ONE SUSPECT WHO WAS ELIMINATED. THERE IS NO BULKY EXHIBIT SECTION OR SURVEILLANCE MATERIAL OF ANY KIND.

THE THIRD FILE IS CAPTIONED "BOOK REGARDING LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY BEING WRITTEN BY EDWARD JAY EPSTEIN, RESEARCH - EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, JACKSON FILE 66-115". THIS CASE WAS OPENED MAY 15, 1976 ON THE BASIS OF A LETTER FROM THE BUREAU TO SAN ANTONIO DATED MAY 12, 1976. IT WAS CLOSED MAY 24, 1976. IT CONSISTS OF TWO SERIALS WHEREIN THE BUREAU ADVISED CAPTIONED INDIVIDUAL INTENDED TO WRITE A BOOK FOR "READER'S DIGEST" RE THE LIFE OF LEE HARVEY OSWALD AND THAT A FORMER SPECIAL AGENT RESIDING IN THE JACKSON DIVISION MAY POSSIBLY BE CONTACTED BY EPSTEIN. THERE IS NO I-A SECTION OR BULKY EXHIBIT SECTION. THERE IS NO SURVEILLANCE MATERIAL OF ANY KIND IN THIS FILE.
