IN REGARD TO JACKSONVILLE FILE 89-18, CONSIDERABLE CORRESPONDENCE BETWEEN THE BUREAU AND JACKSONVILLE REGARDING THE STATEMENT OF ONE WILLIAM S. WALTER, A FORMER SECURITY PATROL CLERK IN THE NEW ORLEANS OFFICE. WALTER ATTENDED A SPEECH DURING FIRST WEEK OF DECEMBER, 1967 AT TULANE UNIVERSITY BY ONE MARK LANE, WHEN LANE DISCUSSED HIS INVESTIGATION OF THE ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT KENNEDY. LANE ALSO ENDEAVORED TO PERSUADE WALTER TO ADMIT KNOWLEDGE

OF AN ALLEGED TELETYPE MESSAGE FRENCH THE BUREAU TO ALL SOUTHERN REGION OFFICES, ADVISING PRESIDENT KENNEDY WOULD BE ASSASSINATED IN DALLAS, TEXAS. WANALTER DISCLAIMED KNOWLEDGE OF SUCH A MESSAGE. BUREAU KEPT AMBUISED BY TELETYPES AND LHM'S DATED FEBRUARY 2, 1968, INMEDIADING STENOGRAPHIC NOTES OF SAC SECRETARY WHO RECORDED INMEDIENVIEW WITH WALTER.
