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THE DUPLICATION OF SERIAL 122 APPEARS TO BE A CLERICAL SERIALIZATION ERROR.

DEFILE 62-3550, ASSASSINATION OF PRESIDENT JOHN F. KENNEDY, CONSISTING OF THREE VOLUMENS HAVING 420 SERIALS. HOWEVER, A REVIEW OF THIS FILE DISCLOSED THAT THERE ARE ONLY 320 SERIALS IN ACTUALITY. THERE APPEARS TO BE A SERIALIZING ERROR IN THAT, SERIAL 242 IS FOLLOWED BY SERIALS 343 THROUGH 420. AN INSPECTION, HOWEVER, OF SERIAL 242 AND 343 REVEALED THAT THE DETROIT BLOCK STAMP ON SERIAL 242 WAS DATED OCTOBER 15, 1964, WHILE SERIAL 343 HAD A DETROIT BLOCK STAMP DATE OF OCTOBER 17, 1964. IT IS THE ASSUMPTION OF DETROIT, THAT WHEN SERIAL 343 WAS SERIALIZED, THAT THE CLERK GAVE THIS SERIAL THE NUMBER OF 343, INSTEAD OF 243, AND THAT SUBSEQUENT SERIALS AFTERWARDS WERE THEN SERIALIZED CONSECUTIVELY. THIS REVIEW FURTHER DISCLOSED THAT SERIAL 345 WAS MISSING FROM THE FILE, AND COULD NOT BE ACCOUNTED FOR.

DEFILE 105-11181, MARINA NIKOLAEVNA OSWALD, CONSISTING OF ONE VOLUME HAVING 23 SERIALS. A REVIEW OF THIS FILE DID NOT DISCLOSE ANY MISSING OR DESTROYED SERIALS.

THERE HAS NEVER BEEN A MAIN FILE ON THE WARREN COMMISSION.
