Based on info received contacted
SA William E. Logg, SRA at Wichita
Falls RA and advised of need
to identify cases presented before
FgJ at W.F. in '64. Subsequently
Logg called back to state Deputy
District Court Clerk on A/L until 9/8
so he had called office of USA at
Ft. Worth and asked USA's secy
for info. About 3:25 pm Logg called back
to state when secy mentioned their
request to USA McCowan he became

somewhat perturbed and had called
the Dept. for guidance & instructions
I told Logg to call USA himself
and explain nature of your inquiry
and if he had any questions to call
Conley at Dallas Office.

At 3:40 PM USA Frank D.
McCown telephoned and stated he did
not know purpose of inquiry and
secondly asked that date of JFK
assassination. I told him the date
was 11/22/63 and as for purpose of
our inquiry he no doubt was aware

of certain recent ~~public~~ publicity concern-
ing Oswald which he readily acknow-
ledged. I informed him we were
inquiring into the matter & had
developed certain info that made it
necessary to identify Bureau cases
presented before the F97 & W.F.
in 1964 so we could ascertain the
identity of agents who appeared.

McCormack stated he had called Execu-
tive Officer of the USA to get auth
to release info noting that there is
not public information and he felt

it might be necessary to obtain a
court order under Rule E. Also cited
Freedom of Information considerations.
He did state that in 1964 there
were 3 FGJs in district:

- 1) January '64 in Amarillo
- 2) April 6, 1964 in Dallas
- 3) October 7, 1964 in Wichita Falls
which lasted for 3 days 10/7,
8 + 9.

McCorm said when he heard back
from Dept he would have an
assistant Alex McGlinchey call

me at Dallas. He stated he should
be able to furnish names of agents
scheduled to appear. I told Mc Lane
if Dept had further questions that
DAg Tyler, now in Switzerland and
Asst Ag Thornburg, Criminal Div.
was were familiar with our reason
for being here and knew the details
