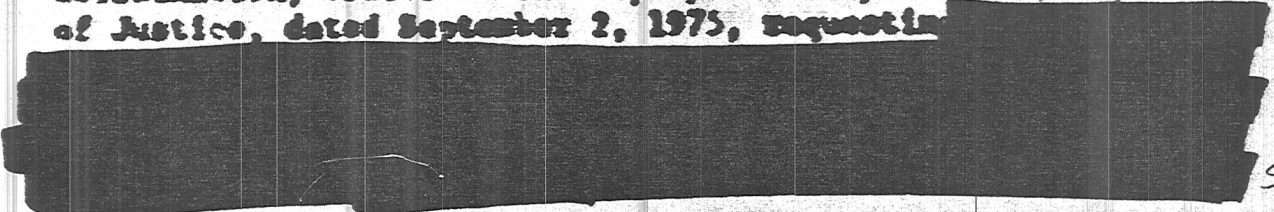

Department of Justice to determine prosecutive potential, if any,
this Bureau is not in a position at this time to accede to the
requests contained in referenced letter of September 2, 1975.

desire to be responsive to HSC inquiries, I suggest that, at a
mutually agreeable time and place, I meet with you to brief
you in a general manner as to the nature of this Bureau's
investigation concerning your specific inquiry regarding the
Oswald matter.

Legal Counsel memorandum to Mr. Adams 9/4/75, copy attached, made reference to inquiries of both the HSC and the Senate Select Committee (SSC) for documents and information concerning the Oswald matter. Above memorandum of 9/4/75, which was approved recommended that general briefings responsive to these inquiries be afforded to both the HSC and the SSC. It is noted that memorandum Mr. Bennett to the Director dated 9/10/75, copy attached, advised that the Director on that date, in response to a personal request, met with Congressman Dale Milford (who is also a member of the HSC) as the latter was interested in obtaining information concerning this Bureau's inquiry into the allegation that Oswald had visited the Dallas FBI Office prior to the Kennedy assassination.

Purpose of this letter is to effect arrangements for a briefing of Congressman Pike, Chairman of the HSC, in accordance with recommendations contained in above memorandum dated 9/4/75.
